

LAKESIDE STADIUM Terms & Conditions of Entry

For the comfort and safety of all customers, staff and participants, and/or pursuant to LAKESIDE STADIUM ("LAKESIDE") Regulations and the Major Events (Crowd Management) Act 2003 (VIC), all entrants agree to abide by the following conditions of entry:

1. All entrants enter LAKESIDE at their own risk, the State Sports Centres Trust (SSCT) will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage by any person entering LAKESIDE.
2. There are specific conditions of use which apply to facilities throughout LAKESIDE. You are required to read and abide by these conditions which are located at the different facilities throughout LAKESIDE.
3. Children under the age of 10 years will not be admitted to these premises unless that child is in the care of a person who is 16 years or older, or the child is participating in a structured program at LAKESIDE.
4. No person is to cause, suffer, or permit rough behaviour or harassment of other persons at LAKESIDE.
5. Persons under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will not be admitted and are prohibited from using the facilities at LAKESIDE.
6. The SSCT reserves the right to refuse entry to any person, or to remove any person from the premises.
7. Alcohol and Glass containers are not to be brought into LAKESIDE.
8. Whilst at LAKESIDE you are responsible for your own property. Patrons are advised not to leave bags unattended for any period of time.
9. Security Cameras operate within LAKESIDE and patrons may be filmed.
10. LAKESIDE is a smoke free zone. No smoking is permitted in LAKESIDE.
11. Patrons causing a disturbance or refusing to comply with requests from Lakeside Stadium, SSCT staff or their representatives (including Security Officers) may be evicted from the LAKESIDE.
12. For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all customers, staff and event participants, and or pursuant to LAKESIDE regulations, and the Major Sporting Events Act 2009 VIC, the following items are prohibited at LAKESIDE:
 - Alcohol
 - Opened Soft drink containers
 - Glass/Cans
 - Musical Instruments
 - Whistles
 - Torn up paper, confetti, crepe paper, or any other similar materials.
 - Animals (assistance animals may enter)
 - Chairs/Stools
 - Flags with handles exceeding 1.6m
 - Flares
 - Fireworks
 - Laser lights
 - Prohibited or controlled weapons
 - Distress Signals
 - Bicycles
 - Roller Blades (can be brought in but not worn or used)
 - Skateboards (can be brought in but not worn or used)
 - Scooters (can be brought in but not worn or used)
 - Any large articles that cannot easily be placed under a seat
 - Any device/s that, in the opinion of the SSCT, have the potential to cause injury or public nuisance.
