

# MSAC

## Conditions of Entry

For the comfort and safety of all customers, staff and participants, and/or pursuant to MSAC Regulations and the Major Events (Crowd Management) Act 2003 (VIC) all entrants agree to abide by the following conditions of entry:

1. All entrants enter MSAC at their own risk, the State Sports Centres Trust (Trust) will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage suffered by any person entering MSAC (including liability for any injury, loss, or damage caused by the negligence of the Trust or its employees or agents)
2. There are specific conditions of use which apply to facilities throughout MSAC, you are required to read and abide by these conditions which are located at different facilities throughout MSAC
3. Children under the age of 10 years will not be admitted to these premises unless that child is in the care of a person who is 16 years of age or more, or participating in a structured program conducted at MSAC
4. No person is to cause, suffer or permit rough behavior or harassment of other persons in MSAC
5. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted and are prohibited from using the facilities at MSAC
6. The Trust reserves the right to refuse entry to any person or remove any person from the premises
7. Alcohol and glass containers are not to be brought into MSAC
8. Whilst in MSAC you are responsible for your own property. Patrons are advised not to leave bags unattended for any period of time.
9. Security cameras operate within MSAC, patrons may be filmed
10. Smoking is not permitted within the MSAC site
11. Patrons causing a disturbance or refusing to comply with requests from MSAC staff or their representatives may be evicted from the stadium
12. For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all customers, staff and event participants, and/or pursuant to MSAC Regulations and the Major Events (Crowd Management) Act 2003 (Vic) the following items are prohibited at MSAC
  - Alcohol
  - Glass
  - Musical Instruments
  - Whistles
  - Torn-up paper
  - Animals(guide and hearing animals may enter)
  - Chairs/stools
  - Flags with handles exceeding 1.6m
  - Flares
  - Fireworks
  - Laser lights
  - Bicycles
  - Roller Blades (can be brought in, not worn)
  - Skateboards (can be brought in, not worn)
  - Scooters (can be brought in, not worn)
  - Any large article that cannot be placed under a seat
  - Any device, that in the opinion of the state sports trust have potential to cause injury or public nuisance.
