



Terms & Conditions of Entry

In consideration of being granted the right to enter the State Netball Hockey Centre (SNHC), all entrants agree to abide by the following conditions of entry:

1. All entrants enter SNHC at their own risk. The State Sports Centres Trust (Trust) will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage suffered by any person entering SNHC (including liability for any injury, loss or damage caused by negligence of the Trust or its employees or agents).
2. There are specific conditions of use which apply to facilities throughout SNHC. You are required to read and abide by these conditions, which are located at different facilities throughout SNHC.
3. No person is to cause, suffer or permit rough behavior or harassment of other persons in SNHC.
4. The Trust reserves the right to refuse entry to any person or remove any person from the premises.
5. Alcohol and glass containers are not to be brought into SNHC.
6. Whilst in SNHC you are responsible for your own property. Patrons are advised not to leave bags unattended for any period of time.
7. The following items are prohibited at the venue; animals (other than a guide dog), laser pointers, distress signals, dangerous goods, loud hailers and prohibited weapons or controlled weapons (within the meaning of the Control of Weapons Act 1990).
8. No bicycles, skateboards, roller-skates, roller blades or scooters are permitted within the facility.
9. The State Netball Hockey Centre is a smoke free venue.
10. Photography and video recording are not permitted.

Hockey Etiquette

- No spitting on concrete areas.
- Please report blood spills to Reception.
- No BYO alcohol permitted.
- No food or drink permitted on court surfaces other than water.
- Place all rubbish in bins provided.
- Please notify Reception if pitch or change rooms need attention.
- Please leave changeroom area promptly after training / game concludes.
- Please do not warm up in the corridors or netball areas.

Netball Etiquette

- No food or drink permitted on court surfaces, other than water
- No BYO alcohol permitted
- No massage tables, oil or talcum powder on court surfaces
- Please don't sit on or around the courts if you have any oil based product applied to your body
- Please report blood spills to Reception

- Please do not use tape on the court surfaces
- Place all rubbish in the bins provided.
- Please leave court area promptly after training / game concludes
- Please do not warm up in the corridors, hockey areas or behind court area while games are in progress
